Appropriates \$50,000 out of the State General Fund (Direct) for FY 2025-2026 for payment of the consent judgment against the state in the suit captioned Charles E. Parker v. Taylor-Seidenbach, Inc. et al., bearing No. 2021-09683, Division A, on the docket of the Civil District Court, parish of Orleans.

Proposed law provides relative to payment. Provides relative to conflicts between judgment and proposed law. Prohibits accrual of interest on the judgment as of the effective date of proposed law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
