SUNSET LAW

OR NO IMPACT See Note

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Re-creates the Department of Treasury and the statutory entities made a part of the department by law

Present law provides that the Department of Treasury and all of its statutory entities shall begin to terminate their operations effective July 1, 2026, in accordance with the "sunset law", R.S. 49:191, and that all legislative authority for such entities shall cease on July 1, 2027. Proposed law institutes a initiation of termination date beginning July 1, 2030, and for the department and all of its statutory entities to be fully terminated by July 1, 2031, without extending the re-creation.

Effective June 30, 2026.
