Proposed law abolishes certain commissions, boards, and other similar entities. Proposed law provides relative to the functional organization of state government by abolishing certain boards, commissions, committees, councils, authorities, districts, like entities, and funds related thereto; to remove references to, provisions for, and the powers, functions, and duties of 29 entities.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law abolishes 29 entities pursuant to the recommendation contained in the October 1, 2025, Legislative Auditor Report to the Legislature titled "Boards, Commissions, and Like Entities" and other information.

The following are the 29 entities to be abolished: Advisory Commission for LA's Energy, Environment, and Restoration; Advisory Subcommittee of the Accountability Commission; Ambulance Service District Commission; LA Byways Commission; LA Centers of Excellence Financing Corp.; Centers of Excellence Program; Clerks of Court Certification Program Committee; Coastal Protection and Restoration Financing Corp.; LA Commission on Uniform State Laws; Criminal Justice Priority Funding Commission Program; Encore LA Commission; First Responders Subcommittee of the Unified Command Group; Floodplain Evaluation and Management Commission; LA. Health Plan Board of Directors; Housing and Transportation Planning and Coordinating Commission; Hunting and Fishing Advisory Education Council; Interoperability Subcommittee of the Unified Command Group; Intrastate Mutual Aid Subcommittee; Latino Commission; LA Music Trail Commission; LA Natural Resources Trust Authority; LA Tax Institute; Medical Disclosure Panel; State Parks and Recreation Commission; Process Technology Advisory Board; Rural Water Infrastructure Committee; LA Sentencing Commission; State Buildings and Lands Highest and Best Use Advisory Group; and Waste Tire Task Force.
