Subject: Increases allowable personal leave days for teachers		

TEACHERS/LEAVE OR NO IMPACT See Note
Provides relative to personal leave days for teachers

Proposed legislation increases the number of allowable days teachers, except those who receive annual leave, may take for personal leave each school year from two to four. This leave will continue to be deducted from the sick leave allocated to such teachers (10 days per year) or from the teacher's accumulated sick leave balance.
