1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "(D)," delete the remainder of the line

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, at the beginning of line 3, delete "through (17)," and after "repeal" delete the
5 remainder of the line and insert "R.S. 56:10(B)(8) and (10),"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 9, after "plate;" and before "and" insert "to provide for an effective date;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 4, delete lines 15 through 29 in their entirety

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 Delete pages 5 through 9 in their entirety

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 10, delete lines 1 through 17 in their entirety

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 10, delete line 18 in its entirety and insert the following:

16 "Section 2. R.S. 56:10(B)(8) and (10) are hereby repealed in their entirety."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 8

18 On page 10, at the beginning of line 19, change "Section 4." to "Section 3."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 9

20 On page 10, at the end of line 22, change "August 1, 2026." to "January 1, 2027."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 10

22 On page 10, after line 22, insert the following:

23 "Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
24 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
25 without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the

1 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
2 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
