WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides relative to waivers under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act

Present law allows the department to use an amount not to exceed 20% of the amount of funds available to the department for workforce training and services to implement state level responsibilities. Proposed law allows LA Works to reserve and expend funds in amounts consistent with federal requirements and approved waivers. Proposed law also allows designation to LA Works to act as the fiscal agent for grant funds associated with the WIOA and to the extent allowed by federal law or approved federal waiver. Proposed law provides the Workforce investment Council to be placed within the office and management and finance.

Proposed law requires the secretary of Louisiana Works (LA Works) to design and implement a workforce system planning process consistent with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIAO) of 2014 and to the extent allowed by federal law or approved federal waiver.
