
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations to Original House Bill No. 232 by Representative Carlson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "forms;" and before "to" insert the following:
3 "to provide for the collection of employment certificate forms;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete line 14 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
6 "requirements; collection of forms"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following:
9 "C. The department shall develop a policy and implement a procedure to collect all
10 employment certificate forms from any employer who employs a minor within this state.
11 The department shall promulgate any rules and regulations necessary for the enforcement
12 of this Section."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 4

14 On page 3, delete line 11 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
15 "Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
16 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
17 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
18 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
19 effective on the day following such approval."
