12 "B.(1) If employed by the municipality or local governing authority, a
13 veteran appointed pursuant to this Section shall meet all training requirements and
14 qualifications for employment.15 (2) This Section does not prevent a municipality or local governing
16 authority from deputizing a veteran honorably discharged for the purpose of making
17 arrests for violations of an ordinance within or outside of the corporate limits of the
18 municipality. The municipality or local governing authority that deputizes a veteran
19 honorably discharged may require that the veteran be certified by the Council on
20 Peace Officer Standards and Training or be qualified by the Council on Peace
