Proposed law establishes a fleet vehicle registration program within the Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV). Proposed law authorizes eligible entities that operate multiple motor vehicles to register such vehicles under a unified fleet account rather than through individual registrations. Proposed law provides for the issuance of fleet registrations on an annual or biennial basis and requires participating entities to maintain proof of financial responsibility in accordance with existing state law. Proposed law authorizes OMV to adopt rules and procedures necessary to implement and administer the program, including eligibility criteria, application processes, and compliance requirements and coordinate with the Division of Administration, the Department of Revenue, and LA Public Service Commission with respect to regulated carriers, as applicable. Proposed law provides for an effective date of January 1, 2027.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law is anticipated to increase SGF expenditures by approximately \$380,000 in FY27 for OMV. According to the Office of Technology Services (OTS), implementation of the proposed fleet vehicle registration program would require the development or procurement of a system capable of interfacing with either the existing legacy mainframe utilized by the OMV or the planned Drive360 system modernization. Implementation within the legacy mainframe environment would necessitate significant programming modifications, with estimated costs of approximately \$380,000. OTS further advises that proceeding prior to deployment of the Drive360 system may pose risks related to system instability and project schedule disruption.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. Proposed law retains all existing statutory fee provisions and does not modify the calculation, rate, or distribution of current registration fees under R.S. 47:508.
