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Requires the office of motor vehicles to educate the public on the use of roundabouts

Proposed law requires the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV) to create educational materials for dissemination to the public on the use of roundabouts as a means of promoting public safety.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law will increase state general fund (SGF) one-time expenditures for the OMV, by approximately \$20,000. The proposed law requires OMV to develop educational materials to inform the public about the proper use of roundabouts. OMV estimates the cost to print materials for public awareness education at approximately \$20,000. This includes brochures, flyers, posters, and other display materials for OMV customer service locations (80), public tag agents (205), driving schools (245), CDL driving schools (50), and partner agencies.

Currently, OMV provides printed materials online on its website. The fiscal note assumes that materials will continue to be made available online, which would result in a minimal impact on state expenditures.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
