Amendments proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original House Bill No. 722 by Representative Terry Landry

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 32:414(F)(2)" and before the comma "," insert "and 415(B)(1)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 7, after "R.S. 32:414(F)(2)" and before "hereby" delete "is" and insert "and  
5 415(B)(1) are"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 20, after "license" and before the period "." insert a comma "," and "except  
8 for offenses pursuant to R.S. 14:98. A second violation pursuant to R.S. 14:98 shall include  
9 an additional one year suspension of the person's driver's license."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, after line 20, insert the following:

16               B.(1)(a) Any period of suspension or revocation shall automatically be  
17       extended for a period of one year from the date the licensee would otherwise have  
18       been entitled to apply for a new license upon his conviction for any offense involving  
19       the operation of a motor vehicle committed during such period. No driver shall use  
20       a license issued to him in another state or the privilege of a nonresident to drive a  
21       motor vehicle in this state, upon receiving notice of his conviction, or of the entry of  
22       a plea of guilty and sentence thereupon, or of the forfeiture of bail in another state  
23       of federal jurisdiction for any offense, which if committed in this state, would be  
24       grounds for suspension or revocation of the license.

25               (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person's  
26       driver's license shall be automatically reinstated upon full payment of all fees  
27       assessed by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor  
28       vehicles, and proof of payment of any fines, as contemplated by R.S. 32:393, or any  
29       other provision under this Title, that resulted in the suspension, cancellation, or  
30       revocation of a driver's license, except for offenses pursuant to R.S. 14:98. A second  
31       violation pursuant to R.S. 14:98 shall include an additional one year suspension of  
32       the person's driver's license."
