Provides relative to the death of a candidate for a party primary office who is not affiliated with a major political party

Proposed law provides that if a person who qualified as a candidate for a party primary office who is not affiliated with a major political party dies after the close of the qualifying period and before the time for closing the polls on the day of the general election, the name of the deceased candidate shall not be printed on the general election ballot; provides that if the general election ballot was printed with the deceased name, any votes received by the deceased candidate shall not be counted.
