Provides for the verification of citizenship of registered voters

Proposed law requires the Secretary of State to annually submit to the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program a check against every registrant in the state voter registration system; provides that any noncitizen registrant's name be submitted to the Division of Election Integrity for investigation and to the appropriate Registrar of Voters to challenge the individual's registration; provides for an annual report to the legislature.

The Department of State reports that proposed law codifies current practices of the department. The SAVE program is administered through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. Currently, there are no costs for state government agencies to verify citizenship status.
