Abstract: Requires retailers who purchase seafood to retain the records of purchases for at least six months and to make the records available for inspection. Further prohibits false or fraudulent records and provides for penalties.

Present law provides policies for testing and inspecting all seafood sold in the state.

Proposed law requires any retailer who purchases seafood to retain the purchase records and to make them available to the department for inspection.

Proposed law provides for a violation subject to civil penalties for failing to retain records or knowingly providing false or fraudulent purchase records.
