Subject: Bail - Commission of Certain Human Trafficking Offenses	

HUMAN TRAFFICKING OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides relative to bail conditions for defendants alleged to have committed certain human trafficking offenses

Current law provides for bail conditions relative to domestic offenses, stalking, and sex offenses; requires the court to consider the previous criminal history of the defendant and whether the defendant poses a threat or danger to the victim when the defendant is alleged to have committed certain offenses. Proposed law adds alleged offenses involving human trafficking to certain conditions of a bail undertaking; adds that the court shall consider the previous criminal history of the defendant and whether the defendant poses a threat or danger to the victim when he is alleged to have committed human trafficking or trafficking of children for sexual purposes as a condition of a bail; requires, as a condition of bail, the court to impose a restriction that a defendant alleged to have committed the offense of human trafficking or trafficking of children for sexual purposes to refrain from certain forms of employment; requires the court to consider the previous history of the criminal defendant and whether he poses a threat or danger to the public in determining the conditions of his release and employment restrictions placed on him.
