8 On page 2, line 19, change "on a dedicated, mobile-friendly" to "through existing websites

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 2, line 20, delete "website specifically offered for that purpose."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 2, after line 22, insert the following:

14 "E.(1) The office of elderly affairs shall implement the provisions of this  
15 Section to the extent practicable within existing resources, and may utilize or link to  
16 existing federal, nonprofit, or private educational resources to fulfill the purposes of  
17 this Section.

18 (2) The provisions of this Section shall be implemented subject to the  
19 availability of existing resources and shall not require additional appropriations."
