1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
3 32:299.3(B) through (E), relative"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 8, after "regulations;" delete the remainder of the line

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, at the beginning of line 9, delete "utility terrain vehicles on interstate highways;"
8 and insert "to provide for restrictions on speed and eligible roadways to be used by utility
9 terrain vehicles; to provide for registration;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 11, after "Section 1." and before "are" delete "R.S. 32:299.3(B)(1) and (F)"
12 and insert "R.S. 32:299.3(B) through (E)" and after "reenacted" delete the remainder of the
13 line

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 1, line 12, delete "32:299.3(B)(3) is hereby enacted"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 On page 2, line 3, after "A" and before "utility" insert "registered"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 2, line 6, after "of" and before "utility" insert "registered"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 15 in their entirety and insert the following:

22 ~~"(2) A utility terrain vehicle may cross any divided highway, highway,~~
23 ~~roadway, or street with a posted speed limit in excess of thirty-five miles per hour~~
24 ~~at an intersection.~~

25 C. A utility terrain vehicle operated on any roadway or street shall be
26 equipped with the minimum motor vehicle equipment appropriate for motor vehicle
27 safety consistent with the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards within 49 CFR
28 Part 571, headlamps, front and rear turn signal lamps, tail lamps, stop lamps, reflex
29 reflectors, including one on each side as far to the rear as practicable and one red
30 reflector on the rear of the vehicle, an exterior mirror mounted on the driver's side
31 of the vehicle and either an exterior mirror mounted on the passenger's side of the
32 vehicle or an interior mirror, a parking brake, an adequate windshield, a windshield
33 wiper, speedometer, odometer, braking for each wheel, a seat belt assembly installed
34 at each designated seating position, and a vehicle identification or serial number.

35 D.(1) Any utility terrain vehicle operated upon a parish road or municipal
36 street shall be registered with the state of Louisiana through the Department of

1 Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, ~~as an off-road vehicle~~ and
2 shall display proper registration ~~a decal~~ issued by the office of motor vehicles.

3 (2) Registration of utility terrain vehicles may include a quick response (QR)
4 code containing encrypted vehicle and registration information accessible to
5 authorized law enforcement personnel. This provision shall take effect when the
6 department's electronic vehicle and title registration system is updated to
7 accommodate the registration of these vehicles and the issuance of QR codes.

8 E. A person operating a utility terrain vehicle shall ~~be at least twenty-one~~
9 ~~years of age and~~ possess a valid driver's license."
