Abstract: Prohibits certain injunctive relief related to aerospace activities.

Proposed law defines "aerospace flight activities" and "aerospace flight entity".

Proposed law provides that temporary restraining orders, preliminary injunctions, permanent injunctions, abatement orders, or other equitable relief that would delay, restrict, modify, or prohibit any aerospace flight activities is void.

Proposed law provides that any claim brought against an aerospace flight entity that arises from any aerospace flight activities is subject to a motion to strike pursuant to present law (C.C.P. Art. 971).

Proposed law bars a claim seeking damages for interference with the use or enjoyment of property, emotional distress, diminution in property value, or any other loss that would be recoverable in an action for nuisance or trespass if the claim arises from aerospace flight activities.

Proposed law provides that a reciprocal waiver of claims between parties engaged in aerospace flight activities pursuant to certain federal law is effective and enforceable in the state of La.

Proposed law provides that aerospace flight entities are presumed to be acting lawfully if in compliance with federal, state, and local licenses, permits, or authorizations.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
