5 Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana has learned of the passing, on March 28,
6 2026, of Roger D. Boudreaux; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Boudreaux served as mayor of Church Point, Louisiana, for sixteen
8 years and was an energetic supporter of the town, its schools, and the local Filipino
9 community; he also cherished following his descendants' sports competitions; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Boudreaux was a member of the Bears Booster Club for over thirty
11 years; he was a founder and twenty-two-year member of Cajun Woodstock; and

12 WHEREAS, Roger D. Boudreaux is survived by his wife, Seina Campos Boudreaux;
13 daughter, Stephanie Aguiard; sons, Nathan Boudreaux (Lisa) and Blake Boudreaux (Skie);
14 "bonus" daughter, Mia Dominguez (Jesus); grandchildren, Drake Boudreaux, Hannah
15 Boudreaux, Gabrielle Boudreaux, Josh Boudreaux, Caiden Boudreaux, Landon Boudreaux,
16 Bentley Boudreaux, Liam Boudreaux, Dylan Stelly, Destiny Stelly, and Slade Stelly; and
17 "bonus" grandchildren, Haven Dominguez, Dontae Dominguez, Izaiah Dominguez, and
18 Andria Dominguez; he will be deeply missed, but the legacy of his love and service to the
19 town of Church Point shall live on in the hearts and minds of those who were privileged to
