ENERGY/PIPELINES: Prohibits the transport of carbon dioxide in rights-of-way used for petroleum transportation

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 30:1116, relative to carbon dioxide sequestration pipelines; to prohibit the  
3 transport of carbon dioxide for sequestration in the same right-of-way as petroleum  
4 pipelines; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 30:1116 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §1116. Use of petroleum pipeline right-of-way prohibited

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no pipeline  
9 transporting carbon dioxide for sequestration shall be located in the same right-of-  
10 way as any pipeline transporting petroleum products.
