Abstract: Requires fuel gas alarms in residential dwellings containing a gas appliance.

Proposed law defines "covered residential dwelling" and "fuel gas alarm".

Proposed law requires covered residential dwellings to have a fuel gas alarm in any room containing a gas appliance.

Proposed law provides the state fire marshal with authority to promulgate necessary rules and regulations.

Proposed law provides that proposed law shall be enforced only in conjunction with existing building inspections, fire safety inspections, or certificate of occupancy processes.

Proposed law provides for issuance of written warnings and a reasonable curative period for violations of proposed law.

Proposed law provides that proposed law does not require interconnection or remote monitoring, and that proposed law does not impose fault or liability on a utility provider.

Effective January 1, 2030.
