Amendments proposed by Senator Myers to Engrossed Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 3 by Senator Myers

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, change "LAC 55:I.207(D)" to "LAC 55:I.207"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 5, change "repeal" to "amendments"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

7 "WHEREAS, Chapter 2 of Part I of Title 55 of the Louisiana Administrative Code,
8 comprised of LAC 55:I.201, 203, 205, 207, and 209 provides for policies and procedures for
9 requesting and receiving criminal history background checks on licensed ambulance
10 personnel and nonlicensed persons from the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and
11 Information of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police; and"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 1, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

14 "WHEREAS, previously parish and local law enforcement agencies were allowed
15 to perform criminal history checks and return the applicable criminal history information to
16 an authorized agency; and"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 1, delete lines 14 through 16 and insert the following:

19 "THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby amends
20 LAC 55:I.207 to read as follows:

21 A. A request for the bureau to conduct a criminal history check authorized by R.S.
22 40:1203.2 shall be made on a form provided by the bureau and submitted to it by an
23 employer or authorized agency.

24 B. Each request for a criminal history check authorized by R.S. 40:1203.2 submitted
25 to the bureau shall be accompanied by the fee of twenty-six dollars as established by R.S.
26 40:1203.2(B)(2) and LAC 55:I.101.A and a five dollar technology fee as established by R.S.
27 15:587(D).

28 C. Each request for a criminal history check submitted to the bureau by an authorized
29 agency shall be accompanied by a letter of engagement or contract with the employer as
30 proof that the authorized agency may request and receive criminal history information on
31 behalf of the employer. The results of each criminal history check submitted by an
32 authorized agency on behalf of an employer will be reported to the authorized agency.

33 D. **Any Effective beginning October 1, 2026, any** criminal history check that
34 contains possible arrest information, shall be resubmitted to the bureau for a fingerprint
35 based background check for positive verification.

36 **E. Effective until October 1, 2026, the bureau shall allow parish and local law**
37 **enforcement agencies to perform criminal history checks and return the applicable**
38 **criminal history information to an authorized agency.**"

39 AMENDMENT NO. 6

40 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert the following:

1 "BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Register is hereby directed to
2 have the amendments to LAC 55:I.207 printed and incorporated into the Louisiana
3 Administrative Code and to transmit a copy of the revised rules to the Department of Public
4 Safety and Corrections."
