

1 report on the outcomes of juveniles who are subject to electronic monitoring conditions in
2 Louisiana.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the report shall be anonymized to protect the
4 identity of the juveniles in accordance with Children's Code Article 412 and shall include
5 but not be limited to all of the following:

6 (1) The total number of juveniles placed on electronic monitoring annually,
7 categorized by judicial district.

8 (2) The average duration of monitoring per individual.

9 (3) The rate of violations versus the rate of new criminal adjudications while subject
10 to monitoring.

11 (4) Demographic data that includes age, race, and gender.

12 (5) Success rates of program completion in comparison to traditional detention or
13 standard probation.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Department of Justice shall
15 collaborate with the office of juvenile justice and each district attorney to ensure the
16 accuracy of the data collected.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the initial report shall be submitted to the House
18 Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice and the Senate Committee on Judiciary
19 C no later than thirty days before the convening of the 2027 Regular Session and each
20 subsequent report shall be submitted no later than March first of each year.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Department of Justice shall submit
22 one print copy and one electronic copy of any report produced pursuant to this Resolution
23 to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library as required by R.S. 24:772.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
25 attorney general for the state of Louisiana.
