SENATE BILL NO. 107

ELECTION DAYS. Provides that the election scheduled for April 17, 2027, shall be a statewide election. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To provide for a special statewide election to be held on April 17, 2027, for the purpose of
3 submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the electors of the state; to
4 provide for the conduct of such election; to provide for an effective date; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. A special statewide election shall be held on Saturday, April 17, 2027, for
8 the purpose of submitting to the electors of the state proposed constitutional amendments
9 contained in joint resolutions concurred in by each house of the legislature during the 2026
10 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

11 Section 2. The election for which provision is made in this Act shall be held in
12 compliance with and subject to the applicable provisions of the Louisiana Election Code.

13 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
14 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
15 by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
16 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
17 effective on the day following such approval.

1 Section 4. This Act shall be void and of no effect if no proposed constitutional
2 amendment as contained in a joint resolution that specifies the special statewide election
3 provided in this Act as the statewide election at which the proposed constitutional
4 amendment shall be submitted to the electors is concurred in by each house of the legislature
5 during the 2026 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

Present constitution (Const. Art. XIII, §1(A)(1)) requires that each joint resolution proposing a constitutional amendment specify the statewide election at which the proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the state's electors for ratification. Provides that special elections for submitting proposed constitutional amendments may be authorized by law.

Proposed law provides for a special election on Saturday, April 17, 2027, for the purpose of submitting to the state's electors proposed constitutional amendments contained in joint resolutions concurred in during the 2026 Regular Session. Provides that proposed law shall be void and of no effect if no proposed constitutional amendment that specifies the special statewide election on April 17, 2027, as the statewide election at which the proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the electors is concurred in.

Proposed law provides that the election shall be held in compliance with applicable provisions of present law (La. Election Code).

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
