DOMESTIC ABUSE: Adds intentional evasion of service of process for certain court orders as conduct that constitutes a violation of a protective order

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides for the crime of violation of protective orders.

Proposed law generally retains present law and provides that a person may be found criminally liable for intentionally evading service of process for certain lawful orders issued by a court relative to injunctions, protective orders, temporary restraining orders, and Uniform Abuse Prevention Orders.
