A RESOLUTION

To commend and congratulate the students and faculty of the Lafayette Parish School System for their first place finish in the Louisiana Governor's Games Thirty-First Annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Governor's Games are the state's premier amateur sporting event; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Parish School System finished first overall in the Thirty-First annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet; and

WHEREAS, Lafayette secured first place by scoring a total of 2,479 points, which outpaced the 2,459 points scored by second-place St. Tammany and the 2,428 points scored by third-place Rapides; and

WHEREAS, the elementary fitness meet competition involves seven fitness-related events: the fifty-yard dash, the shuttle run, pull-ups, the standing long-jump, curl-ups or sit-ups, the six hundred-yard run, and the V-sit and reach; and

WHEREAS, the top two boys and girls from each parish compete in Alexandria annually for the fitness title; and

WHEREAS, Lafayette's top performer, Tianna Franks, led the way with six hundred forty-eight individual points; she and her teammates, Brennon Poullard, Amir Alsayed, and Aubrey Porter, anchored their parish to victory; and

WHEREAS the elementary fitness meet has served as the Olympic Games for elementary school-aged children in thirty parishes across the state since 1997, and more than two hundred thousand students have competed for the state fitness crown.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend and congratulate the students, coaches, and parents of the Lafayette Parish School System on their first place finish in the Louisiana Governor's Games Thirty-First Annual Elementary State Championship Fitness Meet and does hereby encourage all of the participants to continue their excellent work and always strive for greatness in competition.
