TAX RETURN: Creates an individual income tax checkoff for donations to the Grambling University National Alumni Association

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Creates an individual income tax checkoff for donations to the La. Tech University Alumni Association.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law creates an income tax checkoff with which an individual can donate all or a portion of his state income tax refund to the Grambling University National Alumni Association.

Proposed law requires donated monies to be administered by the secretary of the Dept. of Revenue and disbursed to the Grambling University National Alumni Association in accordance with present law (R.S. 47:120.37).

Proposed law creates an income tax checkoff with which an individual can donate all or a portion of his state income tax refund to the La. Tech University Alumni Association.

Proposed law requires donated monies to be administered by the secretary of the Dept. of Revenue and disbursed to the La. Tech University Alumni Association in accordance with present law (R.S. 47:120.37).

Proposed law applies to taxable periods beginning on or after Jan. 1, 2027.
