**HEALTH/LDH: Provides relative to the regulation of food and food safety.**

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DIGEST

Present law provides for definitions relative to the "Truth in Labeling of Food Products Act".

Proposed law adds a definition for "non-lactational dairy protein product".

Proposed law provides for labeling requirements for non-lactational dairy protein products.

Proposed law prohibits the sale of non-lactational dairy protein products, contingent upon the effectiveness of House Bill No. 512 of the 2026 R.S.

(Amends R.S. 3:4743(14) through (18); Adds R.S. 3:4743(19), 4744(C), and 4744.1)

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill:

1. Remove provisions that prohibit state agencies from purchasing or serving any non-lactational dairy protein product.
2. Changes font size of disclosures required by proposed law.
3. Provides for an effective date.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the reengrossed bill

1. Provides for labeling requirements for non-lactational dairy protein products.
2. Prohibits the sale of non-lactational dairy protein products, contingent upon the effectiveness of House Bill No. 512 of the 2026 R.S.
