1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:284(A), (D), and (F), relative to the use of facility dogs; to  
3 provide for the use of facility dogs by victims of sex offenses; and to provide for  
4 related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 15:284(A), (D), and (F) are hereby amended and reenacted to read  
7 as follows:

8 §284. Facility dogs; use in court; procedure

9 A. The court shall allow a any witness who is either under eighteen years of  
10 age, ~~or~~ who has a developmental disability as defined in R.S. 28:451.2, or who is in  
11 a trial for a sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541 to have be accompanied by a  
12 facility dog, if available, ~~accompany them~~ while testifying in court.

14 D. To ensure that the presence of a facility dog does not influence the jury  
15 or is not a reflection on the truthfulness of any testimony that is offered by the victim  
16 or witness, the court ~~shall~~ may order that the presence of the dog be obscured from  
17 the jury at all times and may instruct the jury on the role of the facility dog and, on  
18 the court's own motion or upon request of either party. The court shall ensure that the  
19 facility dog is a trained animal. The facility dog's entry into and exit from the  
20 courtroom shall be done outside the presence of the jury and all precautions should  
21 be taken to obscure the presence of the dog from the jury.
