A RESOLUTION

To commend Paris Saint-Germain Football Club on winning its second consecutive UEFA Champions League title.

WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain Football Club lifted the UEFA Champions League Trophy for the second consecutive year after a 4-3 penalty shootout victory over Arsenal in the final of the 2025-2026 Champions League at Puskas Arena in Budapest, Hungary; and

WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain Football Club, known by fans as Les Rouge-et-Bleu, were cheered to victory by seventeen thousand fans in attendance at the game in Budapest, and thousands more across France and the rest of the world; and

WHEREAS, with the addition of the 2026 UEFA Champions League Trophy, Paris Saint-Germain has fifty-seven domestic and international titles in its trophy cabinet; it also defended its French Ligue 1 title during the 2025-2026 season; and

WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain fielded the second-youngest squad during the 2025-2026 Champions League; the club relied on its incredible attacking depth and tied its own record of seven players involved in at least five goals throughout the tournament; and

WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain Football Club is led by its president, Nasser Al-Khelaïfi, and the men's team is managed by Luis Enrique; the team's goalkeepers are Matvei Safonov, Lucas Chevalier, and Renato Marin; the defenders are Achraf Hakimi, Marquinhos, Lucas Hernandez, Nuno Mendes, Lucas Beraldo, Illia Zabarnyi, and Willian Pacho; the midfielders are Fabián Ruiz, Vitorinha, Lee Kang-in, Senny Mayulu, Dro Fernández, Warren Zaire-Emery, and João Neves; and the forwards are Khvicha Kvaratskhelia, Gonçalo Ramos, Ousmane Dembélé, Désiré Doué, Bradley Barcola, Quentin Ndjantou, and Ibrahim Mbaye; and

WHEREAS, New Orleans-based Consul General of the French Republic, the Honorable Rodolphe Sambou, is a passionate fan of Les Rouge-et-Bleu; and

WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain Football Club is most deserving of the highest recognition for winning European soccer's most-prestigious prize: the UEFA Champions League Trophy.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Paris Saint-Germain Football Club on winning its second consecutive UEFA Champions League title and does hereby extend sincerest wishes that club continue to prosper in all of its competitive endeavors for many more years to come.
