New law creates the Foundation for Moral Law specialty license plate.

New law provides the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) establish a special prestige license plate to be known as the "Foundation for Moral Law" specialty license plate.

New law provides the plate be established provided there are 1000 applicants for the plate.

New law provides the plate be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles and vans.

New law provides the secretary shall determine the design of the plate and that the design shall include the words "Foundation for Moral Law".

New law provides when the department's electronic vehicle and title registration system is updated to accommodate the creation of new plates the plate is issued, upon application, to any citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

New law provides the charge for the special license plate is the regular motor vehicle registration license fee charged under present law.

New law provides the secretary promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are necessary.

Effective August 1, 2026.
