

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 62 (HB 286)**

**2026 Regular Session**

**Berault**

Prior law provided that the board of commissioners of the St. Tammany Mosquito Abatement District No. 2 exercised sole authority for determining the manner in which funds of the district were expended for purposes of mosquito abatement, control, eradication, and study, subject to the approval of the director of the district.

New law repeals prior law.

Prior law authorized the board of commissions of the district to extend any service authorized by existing law (Chapter 23 of Title 33) outside the territorial boundaries of the district in accordance with the terms of a service agreement between the board and the governing authority of any parish or municipality. Further provided for how the service agreement was to be concluded.

New law repeals prior law.

Prior law authorized the board of commissioners to pay the health insurance claims of district employees when the district's employee health insurance carrier became insolvent and was unable to satisfy those claims. Further authorized the board to use surplus funds of the district to pay unpaid claims.

New law repeals prior law.

Prior law authorized the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury to include certain specified areas within the boundaries of the district.

New law repeals prior law.

Prior law provided that if the St. Tammany Parish Council changed the name of the district, such redesignation would not affect the respective powers of the board of commissioners of the district or the parish council.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
