ACT 912 (HB 1126)

2026 Regular Session

McFarland

New law provides for the expenses of the legislature and legislative service agencies. Appropriates \$94,541,665 from the State General Fund for FY 2026-2027 including the following:

Further, provides for the allocation of funds for salaries and allowances of members, officers, and staff of the House and Senate. Provides that the balance on July 2, 2026, of the fund created by Section 13 of Act 513 of the 2008 R.S. is appropriated to the Legislative Budgetary Control Council.

New law appropriates \$350,000 from the state general fund to establish the Legislative Auditor Ancillary Enterprise Fund as an agency working capital fund; appropriates \$25,104,188 from the fund, which is authorized to be used for expenses of the auditor's office.

Further provides for the rate allowable for per diem deduction for members of the legislature during their attendance at the state capitol and for days spent in the conduct of the business of their office as determined by the presiding officers and retains provisions of existing law allowing legislative assistants who were employed on or before Dec. 1, 2007, to retain the salary they were earning on Dec. 1, 2007.

Effective July 1, 2026.
