

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 134 (HB 191)**

**Villio**

Existing law provides for credit toward service of a defendant's sentence for time spent in actual custody prior to the imposition of sentence.

New law prohibits a defendant from receiving overlapping jail credit when consecutive sentences are imposed for multiple counts or charges, regardless of whether the sentence imposed is subsequently corrected pursuant to existing law (C.Cr.P. Art. 881.5). Requires that credit for time spent in actual custody be applied to only one of the consecutive sentences imposed.

New law provides that any overlapping jail credit that is awarded in violation of existing law (C.Cr.P. Art. 880) is null, void, and of no effect.

Effective August 1, 2026.
