REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE: Provides for redistricting of the Louisiana House of Representatives

AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 24:35.5(A)(11), (12), (13), (19), (20), (21), (62), $(72),(73),(74),(75),(77),(82),(89),(91),(93),(94),(95),(96),(97)$, (98), (99), (100), and (101) and (B) as enacted by Act No. 3 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 2001, to provide with respect to the composition of House of Representative Districts 11, 12, 13, 19, 20, 21, $62,72,73,74,75,77,82,89,91,93,94,95,96,97,98,99,100$, and 101, all to legislatively adopt, approve, and ratify the agreement of the parties in The Louisiana House of Representatives, et al. v. John Ashcroft, et al., CA No. 1:02CV00062 (United States District Court for the District of Columbia) to secure a consent declaratory judgment in said matter; to provide for effective dates; and to generally and specifically and otherwise provide with respect thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 24:35.5(A)(11), (12), (13), (19), (20), (21), (62), (72), (73), (74), (75), (77), (82), (89), (91), (93), (94), (95), (96), (97), (98), (99), (100), and (101) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§35.5. Membership of the House of Representatives
A. The House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana shall be composed of one hundred five members. Effective with the opening of the qualifying period for the primary election in 2003 for members of the legislature, the state shall be divided into the representative districts provided in this Section for purposes of election of members at the 2003 regular elections. These districts shall be effective for all purposes beginning at 10:00 a.m. on January 12, 2004. One representative shall be elected from each district.
(11) District No. 11 is composed of Precincts 1-1, 2-1, 2-2, 3-1, and 3-3 of Bienville Parish; Claiborne Parish; and Precincts 1-A4, 1C3, 1-C4, 1-D1, 1-D2, 1-D3, 1-D4, 1-E1, 1-E2, 1-E3, 1-E4, 1-F1, 1-F2, 1-Gt, 1-G2, 2-A1, 2-A2, 2-A3, 2-A4, 2-B1, 2-B2, 3-1, 3-3, and 3-4 of Lincoln Parish.

B. (1) The precincts to which reference is made in this Section in the districts enacted by Act No. 3 of the 2001 Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities under the provisions of R.S. 18:532 and made effective not later than January 1, 2000, for the purpose of establishing block boundaries for the 2000 federal decennial census and for reapportionment purposes. However, for those precincts subsequently changed by or pursuant to a court order or by ordinance of the respective parish governing authority as provided in R.S. 18:532.1(G) and validated by the Legislature of Louisiana prior to June 23, 2001, reference is to precincts so changed and validated.

(2) The precincts to which reference is made in this Section for the districts amended and reenacted by the provisions contained in the Act which began as House Bill No. of the 2003 Regular Session of the Legislature are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities under the provisions of R.S. 18:532 or pursuant to a court order, made effective not later than March 24, 2003, and contained in the precinct database of the Department of Elections and Registration as of March 24, 2003.

Section 2. The House of Representatives Districts established by R.S. 24:35.4 shall remain in full force and effect for all purposes, except for the election of members of the House of Representatives at the 2003 regular elections as provided in Section 1 of this Act and in Section 1 of Act No. 3 of the Second Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, until 10:00 a.m., January 12, 2004.

Section 3. This Section and Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Section and Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

#### Abstract

Provides for the redistricting of the House of Representatives and provides for the composition of Districts $11,12,13,19,20,21,62,72$, $73,74,75,77,82,89,91,93,94,95,96,97,98,99,100$, and 101. Effective for election purposes for the regular legislative elections in 2003 and for all purposes on Jan. 12, 2004.


Statistical summaries of the proposed law, including district variances from the ideal population of 42,561 and the range of those variances, as well as maps illustrating proposed district boundaries accompany this digest.

Present constitution (Const. Art. III, §6(A)) requires the legislature, by the end of the year following the year in which the state's population is reported to the president of the United States for each decennial federal census, to reapportion the representation in each house as equally as practicable on the basis of population shown by the census.

Present law divides the state into 105 districts for election of members of the House of Representatives.

Proposed law reapportions the state's population in Districts 11, 12, 13, 19, 20, $21,62,72,73,74,75,77,82,89,91,93,94,95,96,97,98,99,100$, and 101, effective for election purposes with the opening of the qualifying period for the 2003 primary election for members of the legislature.

Proposed law specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions in present law are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities under R.S. 18:532 and made effective not later than January 1, 2000, for the purpose of establishing block boundaries for the 2000 federal decennial census, except that for precincts changed by court order or ordinance as provided by present law and validated by the legislature prior to June 23, 2001, reference is to precincts so changed and validated. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided on a nongeographic or geographic basis under existing law, the general precinct designation in the district description includes all nongeographic and geographic subdivisions of the precinct. Further provides that the territorial limits of the House districts as enacted shall continue in effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish registrar of voters or the parish governing authority.

Proposed law additionally specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions in proposed law are those adopted by the respective parish governing pursuant to present law(R.S. 18:532 or 532.1)or by court order,
made effective for March 24, 2003, and contained in the precinct database of the Department of Elections and Registration as of March 24, 2003.

Proposed law retains present districts until 10:00 a.m., January 12, 2004, at which time present law is repealed and proposed districts are effective for all purposes.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action (except repeal of R.S. 24:35.4 is effective at 10:00 a.m., January 12, 2004).

Population counts in the summaries accompanying this digest are derived from Census 2000 Redistricting Data (P.L. 94-171), Summary File, Census of Population and Housing, Louisiana (U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census, issued March 9, 2001), as validated and adjusted by staff of the Louisiana Legislature. Population data, statistical information, and maps are supplied for purposes of information and analysis and comprise no part of proposed law text.
