REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE: Provides for the composition of House of Representatives Districts Nos. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, and 60

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 24:35.5(A)(introductory paragraph), (2), (4), (51), (54), (55),
3	and (60) and (C) and to enact R.S. 24:35.5(B)(3), to provide for the composition of
4	certain House of Representatives districts; to provide for the composition of House
5	of Representatives Districts Nos. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, and 60; to provide for the precincts
6	used to compose the districts for the House of Representatives; to provide for
7	effectiveness; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 24:35.5(A)(introductory paragraph), (2), (4), (51), (54), (55), and
10	(60) and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 24:35.5(B)(3) is hereby enacted to
11	read as follows:
12	§35.5. Membership of the House of Representatives
13	A. The House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana shall be
14	composed of one hundred five members. Effective with the opening of the qualifying
15	period for the primary election in 2003 for members of the legislature, the The state
16	shall be divided into the representative districts provided in this Section effective for
17	all purposes of election of members at the 2003 regular elections. These districts shall
18	be effective for all purposes beginning at 10:00 a.m. on January 12, 2004. One
19	representative shall be elected from each district.

9	(3) The precincts to which reference is made in this Section for House District
10	Nos. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, and 60 as amended and reenacted by the provisions contained
11	in the Act which originated as House Bill No. 910 of the 2004 Regular Session of the
12	Legislature are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities under
13	the provisions of R.S. 18:532 or 532.1 or pursuant to a court order made effective no
14	later than November 1, 2003, and contained in the precinct database of the
15	Department of Elections and Registration as of November 1, 2003.
16	C. When a precinct enumerated in this Section has been subdivided by action
17	of the parish registrar of voters or governing authority on a nongeographic basis (for
18	purposes of polling), or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a
19	geographic basis under the provisions of R.S. $18:532.1(G)$, the enumeration in this
20	Section of the general precinct designation shall include all polling subdivisions
21	thereof and all geographic subdivisions thereof; however, such subdivisions may be
22	designated. When a precinct enumerated in this Section has been consolidated or
23	merged on a geographic basis by action of the parish governing authority pursuant to
24	the provisions of R.S. $18:532.1(H)$, the territorial limits of the districts as provided
25	in Subsection A of this Section shall continue in effect without change. The territorial
26	limits of the districts as provided in Subsection A of this Section and subject to the
27	provisions of Subsection B of this Section shall continue in effect without change
28	regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish registrar of voters or the
29	parish governing authority.

1	Section 2.(A) The provisions of this Act shall not affect or reduce the term of office
2	of any member of the House of Representatives elected at the regular election of members of
3	the legislature in 2003 or of any member of the House of Representatives elected pursuant
4	to a special election held prior to the effective date of this Act.
5	(B) Each member of the House of Representatives in office on the effective date of
6	this Act shall be the member of the House of Representatives for the district having the same
7	designation as the district from which the member was elected and shall complete the term
8	for which he was elected.
9	(C) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any vacancy occurring in
10	House District No. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, or 60 occurring prior to the next regular election of
11	members of the legislature shall be filled from such district as amended by the provisions of
12	this Act.
13	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
14	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
15	by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
16	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
17	effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Provides for the composition of House of Representatives Districts Nos. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, and 60.

<u>Present law</u> divides the state into 105 districts for election of members of the House of Representatives. <u>Present law</u> specifies that such districts were effective at the opening of qualifying for the 2003 regular elections for purpose of election of members at the 2003 election and effective for all purposes beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Jan. 12, 2004.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the composition of Districts 2 and 4 in Caddo Parish; Districts 51 and 60 in Assumption Parish; and Districts 54 and 55 in Lafourche Parish. <u>Proposed law</u> removes specific times for effectiveness of the representative districts and provides instead that the 105 representative districts are effective for all purposes.

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<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall not affect or reduce the term of office of any House member elected at the regular election in 2003 or of any member elected pursuant to a special election held prior to the effective date of <u>proposed law</u>. Specifies that each member of the House in office on the effective date of <u>proposed law</u> shall be the member of the House for the district having the same designation as the district from which the member was elected and shall complete the term for which he was elected.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any vacancy occurring in House District No. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, or 60 occurring prior to the next regular election of members of the legislature shall be filled from such district as amended by the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>.

Present law specifies that precincts referenced in certain specified district descriptions in present law are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities under R.S. 18:532 and made effective no later than Jan. 1, 2000, for the purpose of establishing block boundaries for the 2000 federal decennial census, except that for precincts changed by court order or ordinance as provided by present law and validated by the legislature prior to June 23, 2001, reference is to precincts so changed and validated. Present law additionally specifies that certain specified precincts and precincts referenced in certain specified district descriptions in present law are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities pursuant to present law (R.S. 18:532 or 532.1) or by court order, made effective for March 24, 2003, and contained in the precinct database of the Dept. of Elections and Registration as of March 24, 2003. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided on a nongeographic or geographic basis under present law, the general precinct designation in the district description includes all nongeographic and geographic subdivisions of the precinct. Further provides that the territorial limits of the House districts as enacted shall continue in effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish registrar of voters or the parish governing authority. Present law additionally provides that when a precinct is consolidated by action of the parish governing authority pursuant to the provisions of present law (R.S. 18:532.1(H)), the territorial limits of the districts as provided by law (R.S. 24:35.5) shall continue in effect without change.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions in <u>proposed law</u> are those adopted by the respective parish governing authorities pursuant to <u>present law</u> (R.S. 18:532 or 532.1) or by court order, made effective for Nov. 1, 2003, and contained in the precinct database of the Dept. of Elections and Registration as of Nov. 1, 2003. <u>Proposed law</u> additionally provides that when a precinct is consolidated or merged on a geographic basis by action of the parish governing authority pursuant to the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 18:532.1), the territorial limits of the districts as provided by law (R.S. 24:35.5) shall continue in effect without change.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and Governmental</u> <u>Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.
- 1. Changes the composition of House Districts Nos. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, and 60.
- 2. Removes specific times for effectiveness of the representative districts and provides instead that the 105 representative districts are effective for all purposes.
- 3. Provides for the precincts used to compose House Districts Nos. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, and 60.
- 4. Specifies that the proposed provisions shall not affect or reduce the term of any member of the House elected at the 2003 regular election or a special election held prior to the effective date of the proposed provisions.
- 5. Specifies that each member of the House in office on the effective date of the proposed provisions shall be the member of the House from the district having the same designation as the district from which he was elected.
- 6. Provides that any vacancy occurring in House District No. 2, 4, 51, 54, 55, or 60 shall be filled from such district as amended by the proposed provisions.
