# RECORDS/RECORDATION: Changes the effective date of Act 169 of the 2005 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana (Item #67)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact Section 10 of Act 169 of the 2005 Regular Session of the Legislature
3	of Louisiana, relative to the recordation of documents in the mortgage and
4	conveyance records and the consolidation of the laws affecting the recordation of
5	documents; to change the effective date of the Act; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. Section 10 of Act 169 of the 2005 Regular Session of the Legislature of
9	Louisiana is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	Section 10. The provisions of this Act shall become effective on January 1,
11	<del>2006</del> <u>July 1, 2006</u> .
12	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16	effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Changes the effective date of Act 169 of the 2005 R.S. from 1/1/06 to 7/1/06.

<u>Present law</u> provides that Act 169 of the 2005 R.S., which Act provided for the recordation of documents in the mortgage and conveyance records and the consolidation of the laws affecting the recordation of documents, shall take effect on Jan. 1, 2006.

Proposed law provides that Act 169 of the 2005 R.S. shall take effect on July 1, 2006.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
