APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Reduces FY 2005-2006 state general fund appropriations to the Department of Economic Development for support of the 2005 Sugar Bowl (Item #30)

1 AN ACT

2 To provide for reductions to certain appropriations from the State General Fund for Fiscal  
3 Year 2005-2006 for the Department of Economic Development for support of the  
4 Sugar Bowl; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. Appropriations out of the State General Fund (Direct) for Fiscal Year  
7 2005-2006 to the Department of Economic Development for support of the Sugar Bowl shall  
8 be null, void, and of no effect on the effective date of this Act.

9 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
10 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
11 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
12 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
13 effective on the day following such approval.

**Abstract:** Reduces FY 2005-2006 appropriations to the Department of Economic Development for support of the Sugar Bowl.

Nullifies the FY 2005-2006 appropriation out of the State General Fund (Direct) to the Department of Economic Development for support of the Sugar Bowl.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
