AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 45:859, relative to utilities; to provide that restoration and rebuilding of 3 certain utilities is a valid public purpose; and to provide for related matters. 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 5 Section 1. R.S. 45:859 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 §859. Public purpose; restoration and rebuilding of certain utilities 7 The provision of electricity and natural gas is a crucial element in the 8 continued prosperity of Louisiana's citizens and businesses. The swift restoration of 9 electric and gas utilities following natural disasters such as tropical storms, 10 hurricanes, and floods can minimize the devastating effects of such disasters. 11 Therefore, the restoration and rebuilding of electric and gas utilities as a result of a 12 natural disaster is hereby recognized to be a valid public purpose in the best interests 13 of the citizens and businesses of the state. 14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 15 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
