SENATE BILL NO. 31

BY SENATOR HEITMEIER AND REPRESENTATIVE ALARIO

FISCAL CONTROLS. Suspends the requirement for preparation of the continuation budget for FY 2006-2007. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To suspend and otherwise make of no effect, for purposes of Fiscal Year 2006-2007, the
3 preparation of the continuation budget by the division of administration budget office
4 as required by R.S. 39:29(A)(2); and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 **Section 1. For purposes of Fiscal Year 2006-2007, the provisions of R.S.**
7 **39:29(A)(2) requiring the division of administration budget office to prepare the**
8 **continuation budget and submit same to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget**
9 **no later than January first of each year, are suspended and of no effect.**

10 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
11 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
12 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
13 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
14 effective on the day following such approval.

Heitmeier (SB 31)

For purposes of Fiscal Year 2006-2007, the provisions of R.S. 39:29(A)(2) requiring the division of administration budget office to prepare the continuation budget and submit same to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, are suspended and of no effect.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
