20 Section 2.D. The balances for line item appropriations contained in
 21 Act 16 of the 2005 Regular Session of the Legislature for the following
 22 agencies of the state and for public and quasi-public entities or agencies other
 23 than the state, whether subject to or exempted from Section 18(B) of that
 24 Act, which are either unexpended or unencumbered or are not required to
 25 satisfy any outstanding unsettled claims, provided that the commissioner is
 26 authorized to satisfy such unsettled claims, shall be reduced by ten (10%)
 27 percent, provided, however, that for the specific appropriations itemized in
 28 Subsections C and E of the provisions of the respective Subsection shall
 29 control and the provisions of this Subsection shall not be applicable.
