HOUSE BILL NO. 94 (DUPLICATE OF SENATE BILL NO. 32)

BY REPRESENTATIVE ALARIO AND SENATOR HEITMEIER

1 AN ACT

2 To suspend and otherwise to make of no effect, for purposes of Fiscal Year 2006-2007,
3 certain provisions of law relating to the submission of budget requests by state
4 agencies and submission of the executive budget and supporting document by the
5 governor to the legislature and to provide for an extension of certain deadlines for
6 submission; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. For purposes of Fiscal Year 2006-2007, the provisions of R.S.
9 39:33(A)(1) requiring submission of budget requests by state agencies no later than the
10 fifteenth day of November are suspended and of no effect. For purposes of the Fiscal Year
11 2006-2007 budget, the commissioner of administration is authorized to establish a due date
12 for submission of budget requests which is later than the fifteenth day of November, and
13 which in his discretion is more appropriate for the development of the Fiscal Year 2006-
14 2007 executive budget.

15 Section 2. For purposes of the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 budget, the provisions of R.S.
16 39:37 requiring that the governor submit his executive budget to the Joint Legislative
17 Committee on the Budget no later than forty-five days prior to each regular session of the
18 legislature, and requiring that a written copy of the supporting document be submitted to the
19 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than fifteen days following the
20 submission of the executive budget, are suspended and of no effect. For purposes of the
21 Fiscal Year 2006-2007 budget, the governor shall submit his executive budget to the Joint
22 Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than twenty-one days prior to the 2006
23 Regular Session of the Legislature, and the written copy of the supporting document shall
24 be submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than seven days
25 following the submission of the executive budget.

1 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5 effective on the day following such approval.
