Amendments proposed by Senator N. Gautreaux to Reengrossed House Bill No. 42 by Representative Montgomery

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Committee Amendment No. 2, proposed by the Senate Committee on
3 Revenue and Fiscal Affairs and adopted by the Senate on November 18, 2005.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, line 7, after "(2)" insert "(a)"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, delete line 8, and insert:

8 "items of tangible personal that are not for use in a trade, business, or profession
9 unless such trade, business, or profession is purchasing items to replace or repair
10 items of tangible personal property lost or damaged by wind, water, fire, or criminal
11 act as a result of conditions created by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 2, between lines 11 and 12, insert:

14 "(b) No trade, business, or profession shall be entitled to purchase items of
15 tangible personal property without payment of the tax imposed by R.S. 47:302, 321,
16 and 331 before submitting to the secretary of the Department of Revenue a signed
17 and notarized application of the principal, partner, member, or officer certifying that
18 such items are purchased to replace or repair items of tangible personal property lost
19 or damaged by wind, water, fire, or criminal act as a result of conditions created by
20 Hurricanes Katrina and Rita.
