

For purposes of the FY 2006-2007 budget, suspends the provisions of R.S. 39:33(A)(1) requiring submission of budget requests by state agencies no later than November 15. Instead the commissioner of administration is authorized to establish a due date for submission of budget requests which is later than November 15.

For purposes of the FY 2006-2007 budget, suspends the provisions of R.S. 39:37 requiring that the governor submit his executive budget to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than 45 days prior to each regular session of the legislature, and requiring that a written copy of the supporting document be submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than 15 days following the submission of the executive budget. Instead the governor is required to submit his executive budget to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than 21 days prior to the 2006 R.S., and the written copy of the supporting document must be submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than seven days following the submission of the executive budget.
