8 §37:1224.2. Permit requirements

9 <u>A. It is the intent of the legislature to extend prescriptive authority</u> 10 <u>to licensed pharmacists only for the purpose of prescribing emergency</u> 11 <u>contraception and not for any other prescription medications or controlled</u> 12 <u>substances. It is further the intent of the legislature that the duration of this</u> 13 <u>limited grant of authority shall extend only until such time as emergency</u> 14 <u>contraception becomes available to the public without the requirement of a</u> 15 <u>prescription.</u>

16B. For the purposes of this section, "emergency contraception" means17any drug or device approved by the Food and Drug Administration that18prevents pregnancy after sexual intercourse; except that "emergency19contraception" shall not include RU-486, Mifepristone, or any other drug that20induces a medication abortion.

21C. On or after the effective date of this Act, a pharmacist shall be22authorized but shall not be required to prescribe emergency contraception."
