**PURPOSE OF BILL:**

Provides relative to school-based health centers, certain requirements related to abortion and contraception.

The proposed law would prohibit health centers in schools from referring or counseling any student relative to contraceptive or abortifacients drugs, devices, or other similar products. The bill would further require: 1) any consent form that requires the signature of the parent or guardian of a student to state the prohibitions; 2) a contact person be named on the consent forms, relative to reporting violations, post signs acknowledging prohibitions; 3) all contracts and proposals for establishing school-based health centers must recite the law relative to the prohibitions.

The costs that may be incurred if this legislation is passed includes revision of consent forms to include the prohibition statement and contact person for reporting violations; printing of signs that state the prohibitions placed upon the centers; and revision of contracts and proposals to recite the prohibitions. The LFO is of the opinion that the proposed changes could be absorbed by the Office of Public Health's existing operating budget for school based health centers.
