1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 17:81(T) and 3996(B)(24), relative to instruction to students in public schools
3	concerning dating violence; to provide applicability; to provide guidelines for such
4	instruction; to provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:81(T) and 3996(B)(24) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§81. General powers of city and parish school boards
8	* * *
9	T.(1) Each school year the governing authority of each public school shall
10	provide to students in grades seven through twelve enrolled in Health Education age
11	and grade appropriate classroom instruction relative to dating violence.
12	(2) Such instruction shall include but need not be limited to providing
13	students with the following information:
14	(a) The definition of "dating violence", which is a pattern of behavior where
15	one person threatens to use, or actually uses, physical, sexual, verbal, or emotional
16	abuse to control his or her dating partner.
17	(b) Dating violence warning signs.
18	(c) Characteristics of healthy relationships.

20	§3996. Charter schools; exemptions

22	B. Notwithstanding any state law, rule, or regulation to the contrary and
23	except as may be otherwise specifically provided for in an approved charter, a

1 charter school established and operated in accordance with the provisions of this 2 Chapter and its approved charter and the school's officers and employees shall be 3 exempt from all statutory mandates or other statutory requirements that are 4 applicable to public schools and to public school officers and employees except for 5 the following laws otherwise applicable to public schools with the same grades: 6 7 (24) Teaching regarding dating violence, R.S. 17:81(T). 8 9 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor 10 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 11 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
