#### 11 "§3974. Prohibitions; persons convicted of felony offenses A. No local charter authorizer shall be certified which has an officer, 12 13 administrator, director, or any person having managerial authority who has been 14 convicted of or has pled nolo contendere to any crime defined as a felony or has been 15 convicted under the laws of any other state or of the United States or of any foreign government or country of a crime which, if committed in this state, would be a 16 felony. The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to any person who has been 17 18 pardoned or if more than fifteen years have elapsed after the date of the completion 19 of his original sentence. 20 B. No person who has been convicted of or has pled nolo contendere to a 21 crime listed in R.S. 15:587.1(C) shall be hired by a charter school as a teacher, substitute teacher, bus driver, substitute bus driver, or janitor, or as a temporary, part-22 time, or permanent school employee of any kind, unless approved in writing by a 23 24 district judge of the parish and the district attorney or, if employed on an emergency 25 basis, unless approved in writing by the administrator of a chartering authority."
