2	To enact R.S. 33:2571, relative to the position of assistant chief of police in certain
3	municipalities; to provide that the position of assistant chief of police in the
4	municipalities of Broussard, Carencro, Scott and Youngsville shall be in the
5	unclassified service; to provide relative to the seniority of any person appointed to
6	such position from a position in the classified service; and to provide for related
7	matters.
8	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 33:2571 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§2571. Assistant chief of police in certain municipalities
12	A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the position of
13	assistant chief of police in the municipalities of Broussard, Carencro, Scott, and
14	Youngsville shall be in the unclassified service. The right of selection,
15	appointment, supervision, and discharge for the position shall be vested in the
16	chief of police of the city.
17	B. Any person who is appointed from a position in the classified police
18	service to serve as assistant chief of police shall not forfeit his seniority
19	accumulated to the date of his appointment and shall continue to accumulate
20	seniority during the time he holds the position of assistant chief of police.
