APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Carolyn Goodwin v. the City of Donaldsonville, the State of La., through DOTD, and the parish of Ascension"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2013-
3 2014 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Carolyn Goodwin
4 v. the City of Donaldsonville, the State of Louisiana, through the Department of
5 Transportation and Development, and the parish of Ascension"; and to provide for
6 related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Fifteen Thousand and No/100 (\$15,000.00) Dollars is hereby
9 appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 to
10 be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Carolyn Goodwin v. the City of
11 Donaldsonville, the State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and
12 Development, and the parish of Ascension", bearing Number 85817, Division "B" on the
13 docket of the Twenty-Third Judicial District Court, parish of Ascension, state of Louisiana.

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013; if vetoed by the governor
15 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
16 2013, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
